The New Year sees some changes to the team bringing you TLB. Dave Stewart is relinquishing two parts of his job, with Chris Jennings taking on the Current Vehicles section and me (Thomas Young) assuming the role of Managing Editor. Both Chris and I have been involved in aspects of TLB for some time, but there may well be some hiccups while we get the hang of our new roles and I hope that readers will bear with us.

As he mentioned last month, Dave will be continuing to provide country route news and also manage the provision of photos. The trumpet that Dave understandably didn't really blow very hard was to mark the length and breadth of his service to LOTS. He casually mentioned that he had been Managing Editor for 40 years but that in itself is quite a staggering achievement, being more than twice as long as all the previous editors combined. Plus it should be pointed out that when Dave took on the role in January 1984, he had already been responsible for certain sections of TLB since 1975 AND he was the SUPs editor, churning out dozens of titles.

National news, TfL and Politics

2024 will be a year of elections with a General Election at a date to be decided "in the second half of the year" and London Mayoral elections in May where Sadiq Khan is seeking re-election for a third term. Further afield, there will be presidential elections in the USA in the autumn with Joe Biden seeking re-election and could be challenged by Donald Trump. The wars in Ukraine and Gaza show no signs of coming to an end, so it is unlikely to be a quiet year. On a positive note, the UK rate of inflation has dropped to 3.9%, having peaked at 11.1% in October 2022 and the £2 single fare on most buses outside London will continue until at least June.

The Government and TfL have reached a new financial agreement. This will enable TfL to implement the full programme of improvements for vital infrastructure improvements in 2024/25 as set out in its Business Plan. An additional £250 million will be provided for capital investment. This is half the amount TfL had asked for. However, recovering ridership levels on all modes should mean more income and the introduction and building of new walk-through Piccadilly line trains should not be delayed. Plans to replace the 1972 stock on the Bakerloo line with similar trains will be progressed.

The agreement includes delivering the Bus Action Plan, which will support 25k of new bus lanes and continue the roll out of the Superloop network with a 4% increase in bus mileage in outer London and continuing the decarbonisation of the bus fleet. New bus lanes are planned for Bromley Road, in the Borough of Lewisham, Stamford Hill in the Boroughs of Hackney/Haringey and Woodford Avenue in Redbridge. Places for London, TfL's independent property company will continue to deliver a range of schemes with plans for 20,000 new homes with a focus on affordable housing in Wembley, Kidbrooke and Barkingside.

Bus and Underground usage continues to increase with bus demand up by eight per cent compared with 2022. On 'Black Friday' at the end of November, usage of Oxford Circus station was 27% higher than usual. The number of passengers using Superloop route SL7 (West Croydon to Heathrow) increased by 62% after it was launched, with a 15-minute frequency replacing the previous 30 minute service. Not bad for a route that was just hourly a few years ago! The other Superloop routes introduced during 2023 have all outperformed the six per cent year on year bus growth across the capital. The SL8 which replaced the 607 recorded 15% growth.

Claire Mann returns to TfL become Chief Operating Officer. She will re-join in March, after leaving her current post as Managing Director of South Western Railway. Before that, Claire was TfL Director of Bus Operations between 2017 and 2021. Glynn Barton, who led operations on an interim basis will remain to become TfL's Director of Buses. The previous Director of Buses, Louise Cheeseman has retired.

Industrial action continues. Some bus drivers employed by RATP Dev Transit London were on strike on 21st, 22nd and 23rd December affecting routes 13, 23, 28, 218, 295, 414, 452 and N28. On the Underground the RMT union proposes a week of disruption affecting different groups of staff each day so the impact will vary but the 8th & 9th of January were likely to the most disruptive days. On a more positive note, the RMT union has suspended strike action on the National Rail network until at least the spring following agreement of a 5 per cent pay deal by its members.

Corporate and company news

Abellio is rebranding as Transport UK following the management buyout from NS Dutch State Railways last year (TLB 703 refers). By 3rd February, buses will display the new logo and the legal lettering will change on the side of vehicles. Depot signage will be changed later in 2024 or into 2025.

Bus manufacturer Mellor has been acquired by Guido Dumarey. The company went into administration in November (TLB 712 refers).

Go Ahead London has celebrated ten years of running battery electric buses in the Capital. The operator now has 520 electric buses and expects to increase this to over 1,000 by 2026. The first battery powered bus, a BYD K9E entered service on route 507 in December 2013.

Other General News

Bus usage in Great Britain increased by 20% in the year to March 2023 but remains below levels in 2019/20. The highest increase was in Scotland which may be partly due to the introduction of free travel for under 22s. A total of 3.7 billion bus journeys were made in 2022/23 which compares with 4.1 billion in 2019/20. Just over half of those journeys (1.8 billion) were in London. Outside London, the local authority areas with the highest bus use per head were Brighton & Hove (140), followed by Nottingham (118) and Reading (101). The area with the lowest bus use per head was in Rutland (1), then Windsor and Maidenhead (7) which shows the huge contrast with neighbouring Reading.

London Liverpool Street is now the busiest rail station in the UK according to the latest statistics released by the Office for Rail and Road. Over 80 million station entries and exists were recorded, based on ticket sales. It was previously the fourth busiest with Waterloo on top position, but the impact of the Elizabeth line has changed travel patterns. Waterloo is now third with Paddington second, followed by London Bridge and London Victoria. The busiest station outside London is Birmingham New Street. The least used stations were Teesside Airport near Darlington and Denton in Greater Manchester.

The Department for Transport has released details showing that 58 local authorities have expressed an interest in bidding for funds from the second round of the Zero Emissions Bus Regional Areas (ZEBRA) scheme.

In a surprise move, Swanley based **Go Coach has been sold** to Derbyshire independent Hulley's of Baslow. Go Coach was established in 2008 by Austin Blackburn who has expanded the operation and built a good local reputation, primarily in and around the Sevenoaks area.

The **Arriva Click** demand responsive minibus service in Watford was withdrawn on 31st December. It was introduced in July 2020 with a four-year contract to 30th June 2024 but the service was carrying just 10% of its predicted passenger numbers.

McGill's group has launched a new express 'Bright Bus' service between Edinburgh Airport and the City Centre competing directly with Lothian Buses and the tram with a £4 single fare which is £1.50 less than Lothian's Airport Express 100 service.

Brighton & Hove Buses ran services on Christmas Day for the second year in 2023, recording a 46% increase on usage in 2022. For the first time a service was provided beyond the city on route 12 between Brighton and Seaford. This carried almost 600 passengers on an hourly frequency. All services were provided commercially using volunteer drivers and charging standard fares.

In Berlin, BVG has withdrawn its last MAN tri-axle double deckers. The 13.7-metre-long buses were built between 2007 and 2010 and totalled 416 at their peak. They have been partially replaced by 150 British built ADL Enviro 500s, from an initial order of 200. BVG has an option for a further 230 but BVG has no electric double deckers and it is not clear if future deliveries from ADL will be electric.

TfL has admitted that the temporary brand take-over of **Bond Street station** as Burberry Street last September was confusing and resulted in a large number of complaints.

The **Northern line** will be closed between Golders Green and Edgware for a week in April to enable the rebuilding of Colindale Station.

Victoria bus station and Terminus Place have reopened following a six-week closure to allow for resurfacing and other improvements.

Hertfordshire County Council is considering franchising and has commissioned a feasibility study to investigate the possibilities.

Congratulations to John Traynor, former Managing Director at Go-Ahead London who has been awarded an OBE in the New Year's Honours list. He began his career as an apprentice engineer for London Transport.

SERVICE PROPOSALS

The consultation for Superloop **SL5** from Bromley to Croydon was published. As noted earlier, this was awarded to Arriva London South to start on 3rd February, although only for a short term of 14 months. There were 1,359 responses, with "74% saying this will make their journey more convenient, 81% will make their journey quicker and 58% saying they are likely to use the new express service than using a private car." There were a number of alternative suggestions for extra stops, with TfL agreeing to serve an additional stop at Westmoreland Road/Barnfield Wood Road. In response to feedback the route will also stop at Croydon Park Street/ St. George's Walk although the number of stops in Bromley will be reduced from 4 to 3. (*See also tender and route news earlier*).

OTHER SPECIAL and MISCELLANEOUS non-TfL OPERATIONS IN LONDON

Nothing new to report this month.

DIVERSIONS, DEVIATIONS AND DISRUPTIONS

<u>Central:</u> From 8th to 20th December, owing to electrical works in Mooorgate, routes 21, 43/=, 76 and 141 were diverted southbound via South Place, Eldon Street, Blomfield Street and London Wall, with 21, 43/= and 141 continuing via Wormwood Street, Bishopsgate and Gracechurch Street. Nearby and from 11th to 22nd December, owing to telecommunications works in London Wall, routes 344 and N133 were revised to start and finish journeys in Bishopsgate. Victoria Station forecourt re-opened by 29th December (*see TLB 712*). The bus stands and Victoria Place have been resurfaced with a "new design" to reduce the likelihood of sinking under the weight of buses, together with non-slip pedestrian crossings and new lights.

South-East: From 16th to 30th December, although finished early on 22nd December, Westerham Hill was closed owing to water main replacement. As noted in the route section, route 246 gained a special timetable to avoid meeting route 464 on the narrow road diversion as follows, diverting in both directions via Lebanon Gardens, Stock Hill, Sunningvale Avenue, Polesteeple Hill, Ricketts Hill Road, Church Hill, Ship Hill, to Tatsfield, then Tatsfield Approach Road, Clarks Lane, Croydon Road to Westerham Market Square. From 11th to 22nd December, owing to water works in Jerningham Road, New Cross, route 343/N343 was revised to terminate at New Cross Sainsbury's arriving via Vesta Road, Shardeloes Road, Lewisham Way and New Cross Road. From 27th December to 5th January, Pettman Crescent, Plumstead was closed for bridge works between Western Way and Plumstead Road. This is the roundabout that gives access to Plumstead (PD) garage, so a temporary contraflow was used with buses departing the garage diverted via Western Way to Belmarsh roundabout returning via Western Way. Routes 96, 99, 177, 180, 422, 469 and N1 were diverted eastbound via Burrage Road, Crescent Road, Bloomfield Road, Plumstead Common Road, Waverley Crescent, Griffin Road, Orchard Road (restriction lifted here) and Plumstead High Street. Route 244 southbound was diverted via Western Way and Pettman Crescent, route 380 was also diverted southbound via this route, but after serving Miles Drive/Merbury Way and Battery Road loop. Route 301 was diverted in both directions via Western Way and Central Way. Route 53 was curtailed at Plumstead Common and route 122 was curtailed at Woolwich New Road, using route 54 terminal working. Route 54 was therefore re-routed to use the Thomas Street stand in Woolwich. Finally, Route N53 was curtailed to start and finish in Plumstead Road, operating via PD garage out of service.

<u>South</u>: The water works in Poplar Walk, West Croydon was extended to 4th December. Meanwhile the alterations in Croydon imposed for Covid restrictions back in 2020 have been extended until 2nd March 2024, although road alterations were proposed some while ago so may also be linked with re-development in the area. Some stops were changed from 13th January. Routes affected include **60, 109/N109, 119/=, 312, 405. 407, 412, 455, 466, 468, 645 and N68.**

<u>South-West:</u> On 21st/22nd December, Hatton Road at St.Mary's Church was closed for Thames Water works. Routes **H25 and H26** were diverted in both directions via Stanwell Road and Great South West Road to Clockhouse Roundabout and Staines Road (H25). Also, eastbound buses had to double-run via the Animal Reception Centre. Thanks to member Roland for the report. The same diversion occurred from 23rd to 27th November, a collapsed sewer being the cause for this so perhaps further work was

required. Member Ian advises that the Whitton diversions (*see TLB712*) continued to 8th December and should be corrected as follows: **110** diverted via Hounslow Road, Whitton Dene and Rugby Road, **281**/= **and 681** diverted via Whitton Dene and Rugby Road, with **481 and H22** diverted via Hounslow Road and Whitton Dene.

<u>West:</u> Member Chris advises that on 11th December, routes 222/=, U1, U3 and U5 were diverted via Horton Road, Stockley Road and Falling Lane. From 18th to 23rd December, owing to a water leak in Larden Road, Acton Vale, route 272 was diverted in both directions via Bath Road, Stamford Brook Road, Goldhawk Road and Askew Road.

<u>North-West:</u> Further to TLB708, southbound routes in Wealdstone affecting routes **140**, **182**, **186**, **258**, **640**, **N18** and **N140** were restored via Wealdstone High Street, George Gange Way, Canning Road and Wealdstone High Street by October 2023.

<u>North:</u> From 4th December 2023 to 3rd June 2024, owing to building works in Wimbourne Street/Cropley Street, Hoxton, route **394** is diverted eastbound via Eagle Wharf Road, New North Road, Baring Street, Bridport Place, Poole Street and New North Road. From 12th December to 7th January 2024, owing to a pothole in Edmonton Green Bus Station, routes **102/=**, **144**, **149/=**, **191**, **259**, **and W6** on departure were diverted via west exit, The Green and The Broadway, with route 191 double-running via the roundabout. Through buses calling at the bus station on routes **279/N279**, **349**, **491 and W8** operated direct via The Green.

Brent Cross West is the main addition to both versions of the December 2023 "**Tube map**", the rear advert being the defining characteristic. One version carries the advert for the TfL Go App seen on the May 2023 edition reviewed in TLB706, whilst the other carries an advert for Santander bike hire. It *appears* that the cycle hire advert version is distributed in stations serving the area where bikes are available, with the former version being used for outer London stations. Both versions are otherwise identical, carrying Joy Gregory's 'A Little Slice of Paradise' on the cover. Inspired by Transport for London's one hundred-year history of staff cultivated station gardens, Joy Gregory has created a rich photographic collage of flowers. The 'Check before you travel' panel gains entries for Bermondsey lacking step free access between 4th December 2023 and June 2024, whilst special fares account for the inclusion of the Elizabeth line stations at Heathrow Airport. Each of the stations gains the dagger symbol on the map.

The launch of the second all new Superloop route on 9th December 2023 was heralded by "SL1 **Walthamstow Bus Station to North Finchley Bus Station.**" The double sided A5 is presented in Superloop colours and features a vertical line diagram of the stops served by the route. Unfortunately, an error has crept in with one stop being named 'Forest Hill / Bell Corner' instead of the correct 'Forest Road / Bell Corner'. The reverse has information about the route and its place in the wider Superloop network. The leaflet was distributed by staff stationed at key stops on the first day, along with the 'Superloop London's Express Bus Service' leaflet reported in TLB708.

"2024 Events" from London Bus Museum is a double sided slimline promoting the Spring Gathering on 14th April, Summer Festival on 23rd June and TransportFest on 20th October. The reverse advertises 'Shillibeer Place', the museum's shop. Before any of these is "Routes 62 & 145 heritage day Saturday 23rd March 2024." A period photograph of RT1989 on the former route illustrates the single sided A5 sheet, along with a line diagram of the two routes plus narrative about the event and the Barking Bus Garage Open Day on the same date.

Hertfordshire County Council have reissued "907 Bus Times" dated 29th October 2023. The slimline with a black cover is in the same format as the previous edition reviewed in TLB706. Also valid from the same date is "908 Bus Times" for the route linking Stevenage with Welwyn Garden City. The slimline has the same style of black cover as that for the 907. Both leaflets carry a new advert for the Hertfordshire SaverCard, reflecting the launch of three new versions to cover twenty – twenty five year olds, twenty six – fifty nine year olds and those over sixty, complimenting the existing provision for eleven – nineteen year olds.

Taking part in the Ensign Bus running day on 2nd December were M1, MD60, RLH61, RM1361, RMC1477, RMLs 882, 2396, 2405, 2588 and 2734, RTs 191, 624, 1499, 3232 and 4779, RTL453, RTW335, T986 plus Bluestar Enviro 400 SN56 AWX, Ensignbus Metrobus 192 (F292 NHJ), Maidstone & District Leopard 2816, Southend Fleetline 233 and Astromega 245, and Sovereign Leyland Lynx G293 KWY.

Various preserved Routemasters congregated at the Ace Cafe in Stonebridge Park on 9th December, then ran along route 159 from West Hampstead to Thornton Heath before returning to central London to see the Christmas lights. This annual event was to mark the (18th) anniversary of the ending of regular operation in London and attendees (at various stages) included RMs 188, 357, 848, 1033 (reregistered DSL 540), 1214, 1650 (in silver as SRM3), 2097, 2116 (in 1933/1983 livery) and RMLs 2276, 2440 (in country green) and 2746.

The Bromley running day on 18th December saw RFs 368, 395, 429 and 486 on route 227 and RMs 1397 and 2179 plus RT1702 working between Grove Park and Petts Wood as route 94 (the pre-1982 version).

ABELLIO LONDON (BC,QB,WL), ABELLIO WEST LONDON (DH,GW,TF)

Additional information to TLB712 is now known for the 56 Electroliners on order: 3048-58 are for route 306 (QB), 3059-85 for route 133 (QB), 3086-102 for route 381 (WL) and 3103 as a top up bus for the +1 PVR increase on route 111 (TF).

The last diesel E20Ds on route 322 (QB) ran on 6th November, these being 8204/8206. Since then the route has been solely worked by Switch MetroCity EVs (1001-11) aided by a handful of the batch due at GW for route E5, thus far 1015-20.

Route 363 (WL) was taken over from Go Ahead on 11th November and is worked by refurbished E40H MMCs (2569-76) and temporarily other E40D/E40Hs, until the 7 new Electroliners are released from QB (3031-37). To make space at WL to accommodate route 363, route 196 moved into QB along with its allocation of E40Hs (2603-18).

3427 was unusually out on route 45 on 22nd December, with 3418 repeating such a visit on 30th.

Wright GB Kite 1703 (LV73 FGZ) and Electroliner 3038 (LV73 FHK) started the ball rolling in receiving the new 'Transport UK' logos, instead of Abellio London, which reflects the company's new owners. From mid-December buses across the fleet started to receive the new company logos and the plan is that by 3rd February the whole fleet would be treated. From next month's TLB714 edition I will move the Abellio London section to the new 'Transport UK' section name instead.

ABELLIO LONDON continued

The next batch of Electroliner EV buses (3038-47) are starting to be delivered, thus far 5 have arrived at QB. The intention is for 3038-47 to stock route C3 and release loaned 3027-30 back to route 111 (TF) and move 3031-37 to WL for their intended home on route 363.

E40D MMC 2618 suffered frontal damage when it collided with a lamppost on 21st December 2023.

Following the loss of route 450 to Go Ahead on 30th September, the SLS class are being moved over to TH to replace the E200s (ENS15-28) on route 410, with ENS28 being the last of the batch still in use. Just SLS7, 15 and 19 are still to transfer.

Following the loss of route 157 to Go Ahead on 2nd December, 20 x E400s are earmarked for disposal, including T98-109, 186/188/190, 193, 227, 295, 298 and 299.

Some of the Electroliners ordered for route 64 are being stored at EC, until electrification works at TH is complete. In the meantime, ES21, 22, 29-32, 34 are being used at BN, alongside existing Electroliners (ES38-50) on route 417, but also appearing on route 50, 133 and 333.

EMN1 has arrived at E and was seen undertaking driver type training duties in December prior to entering service on route 377 along with EMN2-4 (also delivered and currently stored at E/EC). In turn EN34-37 are due to transfer onto route 318 (AR) to join other E20D MMCs (EN38, ENR1-7) and replace the oldest E200s (EN13, 18, 20 and 21) in the fleet.

Superloop SL1 (North Finchley – Walthamstow Central) duly commenced on 9th December, using HA1-14 released from the loss of route 78 the week before (2nd December). Superloop SL1 is operated by AD garage and E40Hs HA2-14 have received Superloop SL1 branding (HA1 not yet done as of late December). To make space at AD, route 329 transferred into WN on the same day, along with E400s (T260-76). As a direct result, route 102 (AD) is now worked by HVs only and no longer has a mixed allocation of T/HV buses. From the same date, route 34 had a slight frequency decrease.

Superloop SL5 (Bromley North – Croydon) has been awarded to Arriva London South and is due to commence on 3rd February 2024, initially on a 14 month contract, using existing diesel single decks in the fleet. Superloop SL2 (Walthamstow Central – North Woolwich) has been awarded to Arriva London North and is due to commence on 2nd March 2024.

HA41 suffered frontal damage, when it collided with a bus shelter in Tooting on 2nd December.

Several new E200EVs are currently in store at Go Ahead Swindon, including SEe260-71, intended for route P12 (PM) and SEe276-86/88/89 as part of the batch SEe276-90, for route 152 (AL). Both batches are awaiting additional charging terminals to be installed and connection to the National Grid.

With the recent transfer of MHV1-10 into RR to partly stock route 147 and to start the conversion of the route to hybrids, E400s E163-71 have been stood down. MHV63-69 are currently in the process of being refurbished and repainted, in time for the tender award of route 601 (BX) from the 27th January. The first of these arrived at BX in November and were initially used just on school routes 624, 625 and 658, with very occasional appearances on the 51.

Route 78 was duly taken over from Arriva London (AE) on the 2nd December, now operated by PM garage, using a mix of EH/MHV buses, made available from the loss of route 363 in November 2023. Following the loss of route D7 on the 2nd December, WVL423-34 were transferred into AL for temporary allocation onto newly won route 157, alongside existing WVLs (292, 481-3) and E400s already at AL, until their ordered batch of E400EVs arrive (Ee243-62).

MHV18 was a very rare visitor to route 172 on 5th December.

Route 91 is planned to move from SW to NP along with EHV1-16 and WHV50 on the 20th January. In preparation, EHV1 moved into NP in December 2023 for driver type training duties. Route 366 is due to transfer from DS to RR along with SEe200-19 on the 27th January, at which point route 376 would move from SI into DS and start the introduction of E200EVs (SEe272-5) along with other 10.9m SEe buses released from NP and route 444, which is converting to fully 12m E200EVs, thus far SEe3/4/5/8/9/24 have transferred into NP, joining SEe30-36 already in use there. These SEe should be upseated from B21D to B33D by now, confirmation needed please, if anyone can assist? The other ex RA route 507/521 buses are being upseated and are earmarked for allocation to route 108, pending the electrification installation at MG.

The Irizar i.e Trams (IE1-20) for route 358 at Orpington (MB) are now not expected to enter service until Spring 2024.

PV garage had a shortage of hydrogen on the 6th December, leading to VWHs being allocated to route 7, instead of the usual WHD class. A rarity was OME2653 on route 263 (PB) in the afternoon on 12th December. WDE2786 was in use on route 240 (EW) on 18th December and WDE2771 also on route 240 (EW) on 20th December, leading to the regular appearance of the type on the route now.

Volvo BZL MCV VMSS2834 is at PB for driver type training duties, which commenced on 19th December and it is hoped that the batch VMSS2834-42 will enter service on route 384 in the coming weeks. Volvo BZL MCV VMSL2846 is moving to EW for driver type training duties, which are due to commence in early January 2024, with a target date for the batch (VMSL2843-56) to enter onto route 251 later in the month. Watch this space! Likewise Volvo BZL MCV VMS2809-33 are gathering in store at PA for future use on routes 187 and 487, pending the electrification work at WJ.

Superloop SL10 (Harrow – North Finchley) duly commenced on the 25th November 2023, operated by SO garage using BCEs released from X (BCE47087-92) and others made available from the PVR reduction on route 183. BCE 47087-90, 92, 111-119 have received Superloop SL10 branding.

School route 698 moved from BT to AV from the 27th November 2023, along with VH45298-303. Route H14 along with ADH45289-97 transferred from SO to CP on the 25th November 2023, to make room at SO to accommodate the new Superloop SL10. Incidentally the Sunday working on route H14 is covered by SO and is allocated BCEs spare from route 183.

WK has at long last had success in the electrification work and route 235 is now operated by E200EVs (BE37062-84), with 11th December being the first day of an entirely electric bus allocation. An additional 6 BEs from the intended batch for route 226 (BT) are here (BE37089/90/92/99-101) to ensure the route gets a full electric bus allocation. The route was taken over on the 8th January 2022 from Metroline (AH) and for nearly two years has been operated by loaned DLEs from both BT (DLE30258-66) and FW (DLE30238-49). With the BEs now at WK, FW has received its DLEs back for re-allocation onto route K3. In turn DEs and DLEs return to route 33. BT has also started to receive their DLEs back from WK for re-stocking of route 288 and 303 back to full DLE operation (joining DLE30250-7 already there), which will in turn release DEs for withdrawal.

Route 218 (X) is now mainly operated by E200s (DE20094, 95, 149-56) and only a handful of StreetLites are now in use.

A batch of 8 DLEs (30267-74) have transferred into BT, indirectly from the loss of route H17 (RP) for the contract renewal of route H11. DLEs are also starting to transfer into S for the contract renewal of route 72 with existing diesel single-decks, thus far DLE30131/33-36/38/39 are here, which in turn will replace DEs. These DLEs are technically available from the loss of route 265 to Go Ahead London (AF).

The comments regarding odd workings on route 295 (TLB712, pg.25) belong under RATP and not Metroline. The Optare MetroDeckers at X (OME46001-37) are allocated to route 23 and 28 with occasional appearances on route 295 (alongside BCEs).

Optare MetroDecker OME46007 was unusual on route 452 on 16th October, with OME46034 seen on the route on 6th November, and OME46027 the following day. After a short lapse another type new to the 452 ventured out on Friday 10th November when BCE47092 covered a midday duty. Then, on 27th November, OME46012 became the first to visit route 295, with multiple OMEs following on subsequent days.

Wrightbus StreetDeck Electroliner EL1 (LY71 GHZ) was trialled on route 23 from 23th October to 9th November and the bus has since returned to Go Ahead London and is now parked up at Q.

The two Scania OmniCity SPs (40051 and 40206) soldier on at AV into 2024, allocated faithfully to the H98 and occasionally on the 696, 697 and 698 School routes.

VH45192 suffered frontal damage in a RTC on route H12 on the 30th December 2023.

In April 2023 it reverted back to its original registration (SN17 MMU) and was part-exchanged for a new Yutong coach, passing to Pelican, Castleford (dealer) then on to Ensign bus. Finally (for now!) it returned to the Stagecoach London fleet in June 2023, initially stored at T before entering service from RM in September, with traditional roller blinds restored.

UNIVERSITYBUS (t/a uno), Hatfield and Northampton

Additional information and updates

More cars that may now be with <u>Abellio</u> are red Kia Ceed hatchback RE67 CUH and grey Vauxhall Astra hatchback MT68 FNA, both seen at Hatton Cross. Further reports of these (and any others) would be welcomed. Cars WUI 2247 and DU66 VSV have moved TF to GW, with MF13 PGO going from GW to BC. YT06 DDX, EK10 XLJ, ET11 KWV, EK61 WWA, MK12 LBY and GJ23 TSO (which was only recently added) have left the fleet.

<u>Arriva London</u> FL23 JCX is allocated to CT (along with similar FL23 JCZ listed above). DA69 OZF, DA69 TFE, DE69 CZX, DF69 PYU, DN69 AOA, WV69 FZS, DN20 GXR, FE70 OFN and KP70 DZB have been withdrawn.

<u>Arriva Southern Counties</u> LN18 XZD, DV68 WMD, NV68 KMK, OV68 VZC and MD69 OUS are withdrawn, as are <u>Arriva the Shires</u> 9747 (GX13 AWG), 9748 (GX13 AWO) and 9750 (YF13 XUR) and <u>Ensign Bus</u> 801 (KY18 VSO).

<u>Go-Ahead London</u> EO16 PKZ is withdrawn and is now with Southern Vectis, repainted white and numbered 9114. EA69 MWJ has also been withdrawn, though two more vans from the same batch have now been added to London stock (perhaps transferred from another Go-Ahead company) as shown above. Vans EY67 ZCE (from RR) and EA69 MXE (from MB) both appear to now be at Q. EF19 HHE at SI is out of use following accident damage.

<u>Metroline</u> Ford Puma car AY23 KVM has gained an all-over advertisement for bus driver recruitment, described as being "very colourful". Similar AY23 KUG at PV is out of use with accident damage. The allocations of some crew ferry vehicles seem to have changed. For example, Renault Grand Scenic cars MD69 OCR, MF70 NFD and MF70 NFE have been seen at Perivale CELF several times recently, having initially been at HT, HT and AH respectively, while Renault Minibus MD23 RHZ (originally at AH) has since been noted at PA then PB.

Stagecoach London VU69 FYO and WM69 GEJ have been withdrawn, as have <u>Uno</u> AT57 NLA and <u>White Bus</u> 96 (HY54 OPC).
